COURSE DESCRIPTION:

An introduction to advanced techniques in drawing. Explores the potentials working with various media with emphasis on drawing, value, perspective, rendering, proportion, color, and composition. All of the subject matter areas including still life, the figure and landscape are explored. Greater emphasis on personal expression. *Supplies Cost Extra*

PREREQUISITES: ART 101

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon completion of this course, the student will demonstrate:

- Concepts of composition.
- Principles of visual representation (including composition, value contrast, value transitions, edge treatment, color theory, and mass.)
- Composition and balance through demonstration and practice.
- Creative solutions to compositional problems.
- Drawing techniques.
- Learning through independent research and practice.
- A vocabulary of drawing and design terms.
- Information about professions in art.
- Media sources on current events in the art world.
