DPT 115 Digital Photo Imaging I

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course introduces students to computer-based digital image processing. Through the use of digital production equipment (such as cameras, scanners, printers, and photo imaging software) students will learn how to process images in a digital processing environment.

PREREQUISITES: DPT 110

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon completion of this course, the student will be familiar with:

- Harness the strengths of Photoshop with regard to creating digital images
- Understand the concepts and terminology used to describe digital images
- Understand the means by which digital images are created (digital cameras, film and print scanners)
- Understand color and tonal correction techniques
- Learn retouching and image compositing basics
- Understand file management and workflow methodology concepts
