COURSE SYLLABUS

GRM 101 Elementary German I

CREDIT HOURS: 4.00

CONTACT HOURS: 60.00

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course is designed to provide the learner with a solid background in the four language skills: understanding, speaking, reading and writing. Students will learn elementary pronunciation, vocabulary and grammatical principles necessary for comprehending and expressing simple ideas in both spoken and written German. Students will develop reading and listening skills and be introduced to diverse aspects of German life and culture. A variety of technologies, media and other supplementary materials will be used to enhance learning.

PREREQUISITES: None

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon completion of this course, the student will be familiar with:

- Understand German and European geography
- Develop a beginning proficiency in the pronunciation of the German language
- Demonstrate a basic vocabulary of the German language

ASSESSMENT METHODS:

Student performance may be assessed by examination, quizzes, case studies, oral conversation, group discussion, oral presentations. The instructor reserves the option to employ one or more of these assessment methods during the course.
