SPA 102 Elementary Spanish II

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course covers completion of fundamental constructions, vocabulary, emphasis on spoken language. Further training in reading, writing, Spanish conversation and the use of idiomatic constructions.

PREREQUISITES: SPA 101

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon the completion of this course the student will be able to:

1. Demonstrate the use of the following verb forms: imperfect, conditional, past participial, subjunctive
2. Demonstrate the use of indirect objects, pronouns, prepositions, adverbs
3. Demonstrate words of time, weather, seasons, days, and months
4. Demonstrate a basic knowledge of the Spanish land, customs, and language
5. Apply this knowledge through speaking, writing, and translating simple Spanish prose

ASSESSMENT METHODS:

Student performance may be assessed by examination, quizzes, case studies, oral conversation, group discussion, oral presentations. The instructor reserves the option to employ one or more of these assessment methods during the course.
